Cookham Regatta 2008 – Details of Competitive Events							
Dongola Six	A mixed crew of <b>six</b> people <b>(minimum of 2 male or 2 female)</b> must paddle a punt down the course. Previous experience is not essential but novice crews must have at least one practice session. Punts and paddles are supplied.  Crews may be of any age but must contain at least two adults. Soft shoes are vital.						
Canoe-Cats	A mixed crew of <b>seven</b> people <b>(minimum of 2 male or 2 female)</b> is required. These craft resemble two Canadian Canoes joined to form a catamaran. No previous experience is required and boats and paddles are supplied.  Soft shoes are vital. Crews may be of any age but must contain at least two adults. <b>One of the crew will helm the craft.</b>						
Dragon Boats	A crew of <b>sixteen</b> paddlers plus Drummer is required. Boat, paddles and an experienced helm will be provided. No previous experience is needed. Soft shoes are vital.						
Club Challenge	A race in Canoe-Cats with six paddlers and one helm, open to teams from churches, scouts, clubs, or similar institutions. The Canoe Cats and paddles are provided.						
Cookham Challenge	A mixed team of <b>twenty</b> to take part in five events - Dragon Boats, Canoe Cats, Volleyball, "funny-walk" and 'Tug of War'. A different crew for each non-dragon event. Min. 2 ladies to be in each event, nobody to be in more than 3 events The highest total of points awarded for placing in each event decides the overall winner						

## NOTES FOR COMPLETION OF ENTRY FORM

- 1. Event should state which of the events listed above you wish to enter. Please complete a separate form for each event and use the full title of the event to avoid any confusion. Extra forms are available from the entries address on the bottom of the entry form or by ringing 01628 675589 (or photocopy) or from www.marlowthames-rotary.org.uk
- Crew name can be the name of your organisation or a team name (humorous or otherwise).
- 3. Crew details should provide a full list of the names of your crew for the event. If members of your crew are also involved in other events, please note this in the space provided so that their heats can be spaced as far apart as possible. For Dragon Boats please enter the names of the Captain, Drummer and all other crew (please use a continuation sheet).
- 4. Start time for the regatta will be 10.00hrs on Saturday, 6th September. If your team has a good reason for avoiding the first few heats then please show your earliest available time here with a brief explanation.
- 5. Agreement and authority is a vital section, which must be signed by the crew captain who should ensure that all the crew are aware of the commitment that has been made on their behalf. Competitors under the age of 18 must also obtain a signature from their parent of guardian agreeing that race organisers shall not be liable for loss, damage, death or personal injury to participants howsoever caused, and confirming that children are swimmers and will abide by Regatta rules. One parent, guardian or responsible person's signature is required for each under-18 member of the crew.
- 6. Entry fees for each event are listed below Regatta admission is included for each named entrant

Entry fees for unsuccessful entries will be refunded in full although, for administrative purposes, they maybe banked by the Regatta in the short term.

Regatta admission charges for <u>non-contestants</u> are £5:00 for adults; £1:00 for children. Entry fee for Cookham Challenge is £250 total **including admission for 20 people**
