

This course aims to look at the careers and distinctive styles of six major European filmmakers:

- Wim Wenders
- Paul Verhoeven
- Paulo Sorrentino
- Mike Leigh

Students will gain an understanding of the work of these filmmakers and will learn how to compare and analyse the elements of film form.

# **Course Description**

We will look at filmmakers from 6 different European countries over the last 40 years. Those we have chosen have met international acclaim and come to represent their national cinemas, yet stand distinct from them as well.

Each week, we look at a single director and view two films, one earlier, and one more recent. The course will help familiarise students with modern filmmakers, the elements of style, and how to understand and analyse the elements of film form.

Students will see how filmmakers can work in unique and personal ways, addressing consistent themes and aesthetics. The course will end with a final lesson recapping what was learned, a discussion on the films and filmmakers explored, and recommendations for other filmmakers of interest.
