# A super 2015 visit to St Benoit

This year it was the turn of Cookham to visit St. Benoit, and a group travelled there by car, boat and plane at the end of October to enjoy a weekend of French hospitality.

We were welcomed at a reception in the Town Hall, hosted by the Deputy Mayor, Mr Bernard Peterlongo. He spoke about the Battle of Agincourt, almost exactly 600 years ago on October 25<sup>th</sup> 1415, which although the English won, eventually led to a more united France.

One of the visits the next day, was to the Futuroscope Theme Park, while others went off to visit historical sites near St Benoit, including St Savin Abbey with over 400 m<sup>2</sup> of frescoes from the Middle Ages depicting biblical scenes, a building listed by UNESCO.

In the evening, a welcome party was organised by our hosts, with a jazz band from St Benoit who invited Richard Kellaway from our group to join them for some of their numbers.

The following day we had great weather for our group visit to La Rochelle. An English speaking guide had been organised, and we learnt about the city's history. As the weather was so good, the afternoon was spent on the IIe de Re, now connected to La Rochelle by a bridge. It has beautiful little ports and large sandy beaches, both of which were enjoyed.

On Tuesday it was time to depart and we set off for home with memories of another excellent Twinning experience. We look forward to welcoming a group from St Benoit in 2016.
