A COMMUNITY ART PROJECT FOR THE TRINITY FESTIVAL COOKHAM 2005

The idea is to get everyone in the community involved in making three-dimensional figures to decorate the Cookhams for the festival. From putting a scarecrow in the front garden, to sugar- icing figures in a shop window, everyone can use their skills to take part, as an added incentive, there will be modest prizes in the following categories;

Children –under 12. Young people 12-16. Adults. Group entries.

The rules for entry...

- All figures must be entered with a completed entry form.
- Figures (may be entered singly or as a group,) can be of any size but the Artist/s must take responsibility
 for displaying work and removing work after the festival unless by prior arrangement in exceptional
 circumstances.
- The Artist/s must take reasonable care with security both of their work, and where applicable, of the general public, the organisers cannot accept responsibility for damage to either.

(It would be favourable if Artists could find the location to display their figure/s and liaise directly with the land owner /property owner as appropriate, as practical considerations may affect your design.)

- Figures should be ready for judging on April 20th 2005 and removed after May 2nd.
- The judging panel will be made up from representatives of the organising committee, and from the parish council.
- Figures will be judged on originality and creative use of materials, as well as skill in execution, and artistic vision.
- Prizes will be awarded at the closing reception, on Monday 2nd May 2005 in the River Room at the Odney Club to which everyone is welcome. Prizes will be announced at 12 o'clock.
